Matthew Passion with Los Angeles Opera in a semistaged production, plus singing the title role in Le nozze di Figaro in a return to Seattle Opera, Escamillo in Carmen both for his debut with Santa Fe Opera and at Chicago Opera Theater, the King in a new version of Massenet's Cinderella with the Metropolitan Opera, and Leporello in Don Giovanni with Opera San Antonio.
